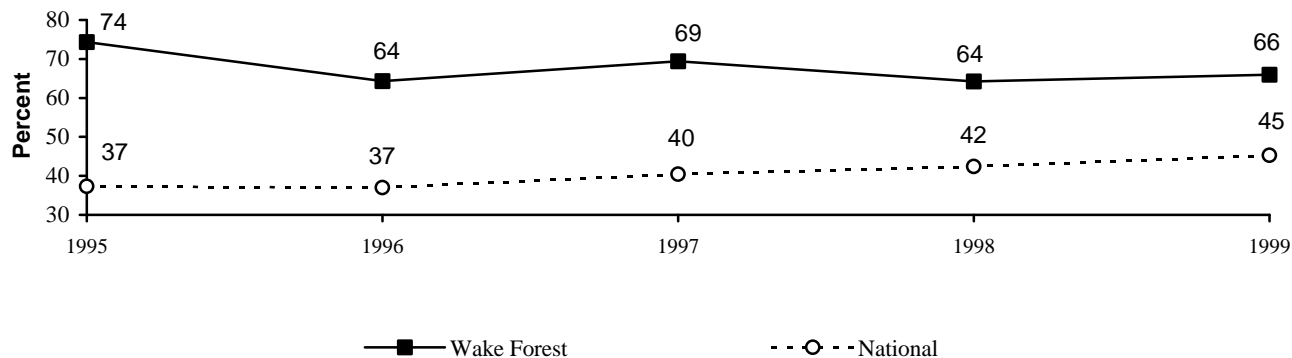


## Acceptance Rates to Medical School, 1995-1999

## Medical School Matriculations, 1995-1999

Since 1988, Wake Forest students have been accepted by 73 of the 125 allopathic medical schools in the United States. 73.9% of those entering allopathic medical schools entered an institution in their home state. 46.2% of Wake Forest students entering Wake Forest University School of Medicine were from outside North Carolina. The top five institutions accepting Wake Forest students were, in order, WFU (53.8% in-state), UNC (95.9% in-state), ECU (100% in-state), MCG (100% in-state), and MUSC (95.8% in-state).
